

# ***Additional COVID-19 Vaccine Appointments for the Following Populations***

**Per the Governor's amended Executive Order, the Bradford and Union County Health Departments have opened additional COVID vaccine appointment slots for any qualifying resident wishing to get their first dose of the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine.**

**Beginning March 15, 2021, qualified individuals include:**

- Long-term care residents & staff**
- Health care staff with direct patient care**
- Sworn law enforcement officers age 50 & older**
- Individuals that are deemed medically vulnerable by a physician**
- Persons 60 years of age and older**
- K-12 school employees age 50 and older**
- Firefighters age 50 years and older**

**All vaccine is BY APPOINTMENT only.**

**Appointments can be made by calling or emailing either health department.**

**Medically vulnerable individuals must present with a completed DOH form that is signed by a physician.**

**Vaccine candidates will be required to show proof of age, eligibility, and temporary residence in Florida if from out of state**
